CEMETERY PRICE INCREASES Due to increasing perpetual care costs and future needs of the cemetery, the Cemetery Committee and the Vestry have approved a price increase for lots and Memorial Garden Wall listings effective March 1, 2023 as follows: Lots for Members & family - \$1,875 (current) increased to \$2,550; Wall listings for Members & family - \$750 (current) increased to \$1,275. The price for non-member lots will remain at \$3,750. The above prices include a portion considered as a charitable contribution to the Foundation. Each lot can accommodate up to four biodegradable urns or one casket. The Wall listing includes interment of ashes in the Memorial Garden.
